ANNUAL HEALTH EXAMINATION OF PETS - This is a thorough physical examination to evaluate your pet's health. **This is required each year before any vaccines can be administered and is recommended for a complete evaluation of your pet's current condition.**

Distemper/Upper Respiratory Vaccine: This is administered to adult cats every three years to ensure your cat's protection against these many viruses.

Rabies Vaccine: This is required by law. Choose 1 or 2

1. **One Year Vaccine** - specifically designed for cats. This vaccine is recommended for all cats, because there is a small chance that cats will react to the 3 year vaccine with a cancerous growth under the skin where the vaccine is given.

2. **Three Year Vaccine** - the same vaccine given to dogs. There is some risk associated with this vaccine in cats. See Option 1.

Yearly Fecal Check: This test checking for intestinal parasites is recommended for all cats and is required for all boarding cats.

Yearly Wellness Blood work: This is recommended for all cats. It includes a complete blood count to look at the red and white blood cells and a short chemistry panel to monitor internal organ function. This helps us stay abreast of your cat's internal health.

Cats that go outdoors are at risk of contagious diseases from other cats. We recommend all cats that go outdoors be vaccinated against Feline Leukemia and Feline Immunodeficiency Viruses.

Feline Leukemia Virus Vaccine: A series of 2 vaccines, 3 weeks apart is required to start immunity followed by a yearly vaccine.

Feline Immunodeficiency Virus Vaccine: A series of 3 vaccines at 3-week intervals is required to start immunity followed by a yearly vaccine.

If we don't have any record of your cat being **tested for Feline Leukemia and Feline Immunodeficiency Viruses**, we require testing prior to vaccinations and boarding.
