ANNUAL HEALTH EXAMINATION OF PET: This is a thorough physical examination to evaluate your pet's health. **This is required each year before any vaccines can be administered and is recommended for a complete evaluation of your pet's current condition.**

Please indicate your preferences on the following options where indicated:

Yearly Distemper Parvo Vaccine versus Titer Testing: **Choose 1 or 2**

1. **Distemper/Parvo Vaccine**
2. **Distemper and Parvo Titer Test:** The titer test measures immunity from previous vaccines. Some dogs remain protected for longer than one year. If booster vaccines are required, we will call to let you know and there is no charge for those booster vaccines. We recommend this test over vaccinations every year because it is the best way of ensuring that your dog is protected from these viruses, without over vaccinating them.

Yearly Heartworm Check: **Choose 1, 2, or 3**

1. **Heartworm Check** sent to the laboratory
2. **Heartworm Wellness Check:** This includes a complete blood count to look at the red and white cells and a short chemistry panel to monitor internal organ function. We recommend this test as it allows us to stay abreast of your dog's internal health.
3. **Heartworm & Tick Carried Disease Check:** This heartworm check also tests for diseases that can be spread by tick bites including Ehrlichia Canis, Lyme Disease, and Anaplasma. We recommend this test for dogs that are exposed to a significant number of ticks. Wellness blood work can be added to this test.

Yearly Fecal Check: This test checking for intestinal parasites is recommended for all dogs and is required for all pets that stay here long enough to be walked in our yard.

Yearly Bordetella (Kennel Cough) Vaccine: This is recommended for all dogs that are exposed to a significant number of other dogs. This is required for all boarding, grooming, and drop off pets. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the **Canine flu** vaccine, ask one of our veterinarians.

Lyme Vaccine: This vaccine is recommended for any dogs whose lifestyle involves significant tick exposure. An initial series of 2 vaccines 3 weeks apart is followed by a yearly vaccine.

Rabies Vaccine (3 year): This vaccine is required by law.
