**Dental Identifications and Mass
 Disasters**

Dr. Weems will discuss victim identification in cases of homicide or accidental death through the analysis and comparison of antemortem and postmortem clinical and radiographic dental findings. Mass disasters, with great loss of life and disinterred caskets related to hurricanes and flooding, take this task to an even higher level of difficulty and scrutiny. In this course a variety of homicide investigations requiring victim identification through the comparison of dental records will be presented. Additionally, Dr. Weems' work involving the World Trade Center in 2001 and Hurricane Katrina will be discussed.
